Job Purpose:

As the senior leader of Hope Community Church Aintree, provide strategic leadership and spiritual oversight of all aspects of church ministry. Primary responsibilities include preaching, teaching, pastoral care, and overall church leadership.

Key areas of responsibility:

- Development and implementation of the vision and strategy of the church.
- Development and coordination of missional and community-focused activity.
- Champion new ways for the church to demonstrate the love of Jesus and tangibly meet the needs of our local community.
- Coordinate and lead evangelistic events.
- Head up various teams and ministries; motivating church members to get involved.
- Work with our Elders in providing pastoral care and spiritual leadership; seeking to serve and shepherd all within our church family.
- Work with our Children's and Youth Worker to disciple and grow the faith of our children and young people, as well as reaching families in the community.
- Develop Sunday and weekly worship and discipleship opportunities, and deliver engaging, and biblically based sermons.
- Lead and administer communion, baptisms, and conduct dedications, weddings, and funerals.
- Engender a culture of faith, love, and service within the church, leading by example, and with an outward focus on seeking and saving the lost.
- Facilitate spiritual growth and discipleship, equipping the church for evangelism and mission.
- Build relationships within the community, such as with local schools and businesses, and be an effective witness as a disciple of Jesus.
- Work with the Centre Manager to ensure the church is administered successfully.
- Ensure all aspects of safeguarding, and health and safety are adhered to.

Committed to seeking God's glory through strengthening the local church and bringing the gospel to the local community and beyond.
